This publication provides data relating to the activities carried out in the Ministry of Agriculture, Ministry of Forestry, as well as Department of Agro-meteorological and Water Resource Management of Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta.

- i. The Produce section which contains information on the major cash crops graded in the state.
- ii. The Livestock section provides information on the different types of livestock passing through the various control posts in the State as well as the number slaughtered monthly for human consumption.
- iii. The Fishery section which contains data on fisheries and related activities in the State.
- iv. The Forestry section gives an account of forestry statistics in the State.
- v. The Agro-Climatological Statistics section contains information on the Weather as supplied by the Department of Agro- Meteorological and Water Resources Management, FUNAAB.
- vi. The Agro-services section and Agricultural finances section contains information on the activities of the Agro Services Corporation and State Finances on Agriculture.

OBSERVATIONS

WEATHER STATISTICS (Tables 1 – 4)

In 2017, the highest amount of rainfall was experienced in the month of July with an average of 156.10mm, a decrease of 72.90 over 229mm recorded in September 2016. Total rainfall also decreases by 291.90mm from 1146.30mm in 2016 to 854.40mm in 2017. Maximum and Minimum average monthly temperature figures recorded in 2016 were 32.86°C and 23.22°C respectively, compared to 32.67 °C and 23.06 °C in 2017.

PRODUCE (Table 5 – 10)

The total quantity of cocoa graded in 2016 was 7,659.500 tonnes while 5,343.000 tonnes was graded in 2017 reflecting a decrease of 2,316.500 tonnes.

Ijebu East Local Government produced the highest quantity of Cocoa graded in the State in 2017 with 2,849.500 tonnes representing 53.33% of the total quantity graded.

Table 8 revealed that a total of 6,269.750 tonnes of Palm kernel was graded in 2016 while 5,523.500 tonnes was graded in 2017 reflecting a decrease of 746.250 tonnes.

LIVESTOCK (Table 11 – 21)

Remo control post recorded the highest number of cattle passing through control post in 2017 with 171,025. There was an increase of 93,372 in the total number of cattle passing through the control posts in 2017 over 77,653 recorded in 2016.

Tables 16 showed that the total number of cattle slaughtered decreased from 184,573 as recorded in 2016 to 161,547 recorded in 2017.

FISHERY (Table 22 – 23)

Total number of existing fish ponds increased from 16,256 in 2016 to 17,542 in 2017.

FORESTRY (Table 24-29)

Number of trees felled inside Forest reserves decreased from 55,417 in 2016 to 35,149 in 2017.

AGRO- SERVICES AND AGRICULTURAL FINANCES (Table 30 -37)

Budgetary Allocation for Agricultural Sector increased from N7,976,813,000.00 in 2016 to N9,531,500,000.00 in 2017 (i.e. by 16.31%). Similarly Actual expenditure also increased from N1,590,613,289.57 in 2016 to N7,754,956,398.80 in 2017 (i.e. by 79.49%).
